The Public Right-of-Way Accessibility (PROWAG) address accessibility of sidewalks, crosswalks, traffic signals and other elements of the public right-of-way. This session overviews the current criteria for accessible public rights-of-way, including the pedestrian access route, curb ramps and detectable warnings, accessible pedestrian signals, street furniture, on-street parking and temporary traffic control requirements for pedestrians.
