## Overview

It is critical that local governments recognize their obligation to upgrade streets, sidewalks, and facilities for accessibility. ADA requires that public agencies perform self-evaluations and prepare transition plans. This workshop reviews the background to, contents of and enforcement of the self-evaluation and transition plan requirements. A case study critique of an actual transition plan is presented to illustrate these items. Participants will leave the workshop with a “To-Do” list of next steps their agency needs to take along with a toolkit of helpful resources.

The current criteria for accessible public rights-of-way (under the Public Rights of Way Accessibility Guidelines Final Rule or PROWAG), including the pedestrian access route, curb ramps and detectable warnings, pedestrian crossings, street furniture and on-street parking will be described. Guidance will be presented on inspecting new and existing curb ramps. The workshop will conclude with a field activity featuring wheelchairs, canes and low-vision goggles to navigate sidewalks and streets in downtown Moundsville.
